

Grammar point 2 : object pronouns

Pronoms sujets personnels	Pronoms compléments
I (je)	me
You (tu)	you
He (il)	him
She (elle)	her
It (il/elle objet)	it
We (nous)	us
You (vous)	you
They (ils)	them

Here's a little dialogue to show you:

Voici un petit dialogue pour voir :

- Fiona, I love you. Do you love me?
- Oh Charles, I like you, but I don't love you.
- But why? Is it Adam. Do you love him? Look at what I've got. A big house, cars, fine wines. Adam can't provide them, can he?
- I don't want them. I don't want you. Money? I don't want it. Adam is all I want. I want him and only him.



Notice that object pronouns always follow the verb.
