

Grammar point 1 : the past of BE

To use the past tense of the verb 'BE' in English, you need to choose between two forms: **WAS** and **WERE**:

Pour bien utiliser le verbe ETRE en anglais, il faut choisir une des deux formes selon le sujet :

I, You, We, They + **WERE** (NOT)

He, she, it + **WAS** (NOT)

I **was** in Paris yesterday.

They **weren't** at school on Monday.

To make question, you just need to invert the subject and the verb:

Pour faire une question, il suffit d'inverser le sujet et le verbe :

Were you at home last night?

Where **was** he born?

Was he with you?
